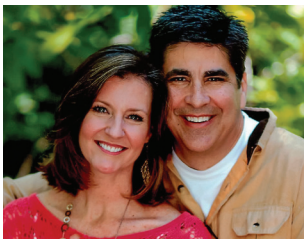


SPEAKERS
